



# NO STOPPING

We wish to remind you that **the zone in front of the school** (from the crosswalk to the alley) is for **busses only** and is strictly a

**NO PARKING zone from 7:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. school days.**

If you are here to drop off or pick up your child (including morning kindergarten), to volunteer, or to run into the school “*briefly*” for any amount of time, you still **MAY NOT STOP** in this area.

This zone allows our school busses to park safely – **including for mid-day field trips** – and delivery vehicles to make their stops. They need **full and unimpeded access to the bus zone**. Please park across from the school or along the perimeter of the field. As well, please do not park or wait to pick up your child in the staff parking lot. The number of vehicles varies throughout the day with substitute teachers, SEE staff and other school personnel who need a place to park. We are often short of space and there is no supervision in this area.

When parking residentially – whether for pick-up/drop-off, for interviews, for council and board meetings, or for concerts – **please do not block the access to our neighbors’ driveways.** Please do **not park within 5 meters of a crosswalk or corner.** This is a violation of parking regulations and will be **ticketed!**

Thank you for your understanding and your daily efforts to respect these parking regulations. The residents in our area deserve to be treated respectfully by all of us. Please park appropriately. Finally, FFCA does not tolerate disrespectful or abusive behavior. We know our parents are character people who strive to be good neighbors and problem-solvers. ☺ We work very hard to have a positive relationship with our neighbors and the community and we appreciate your support in keeping a good reputation.



## TRAFFIC SAFETY



For the safety of the children and innocent drivers, **please ensure that you and/or your child ALWAYS USE THE CROSSWALK.** It is extremely dangerous for children to run across the road with limited visibility of oncoming traffic. We recommend that you accompany younger children when crossing the street in the crosswalk. **ABSOLUTELY NEVER CROSS BETWEEN BUSES** as oncoming drivers can not see around the much larger vehicles. **We strongly encourage all adults to use the crosswalk even when they think no one is looking. Someone usually is!** ☺

All of us who drive dread the possibility of a child stepping unexpectedly onto the road. Accidents can and do happen. No one wants to be the driver or the parent of a child who is hurt. Please respect these safety rules for everyone's sake. Thank you for your care and cooperation.
